BAND CAMP

Band camp is a fun and engaging experience for young musicians who wish to enhance their musical skills and abilities and learn from highly professional and motivating instructors in a relaxed summer atmosphere. Meeting new friends, individualized instruction, and ensemble performance experience are hallmarks of Summer Band Camp at MNPS.

Students must have completed one school year in band before attending camp. They also must commit to attending all days of camp and participating in the concert.

The concert will be at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, June 14 at West End Middle School. Concert dress will be dark slacks or skirt and camp t-shirt.

Seating auditions will be held on the first day of camp. Students will be placed in one of three concert bands depending upon their scale knowledge, technique, tone quality, and age/ experience. Students should prepare for their audition by practicing the familiar scales from their band's curriculum. Students with 1–2 years of band are expected to perform a Bb concert scale and/or a 1-octave chromatic scale. Students with 3–4 years of experience are expected to perform the MTSBOA Mid state band requirements. Percussion students should contact their Band Director for audition information.
